

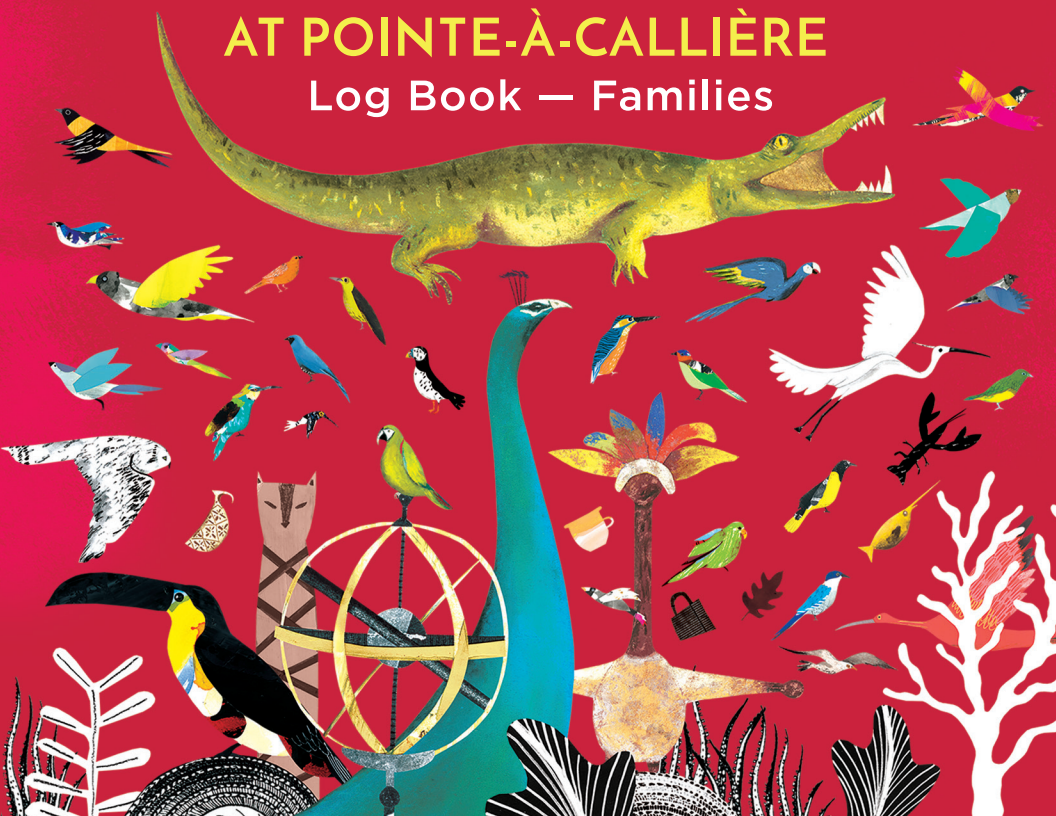

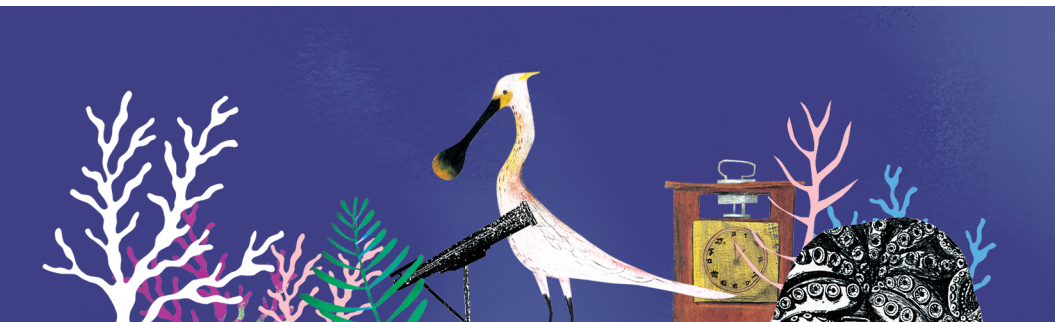
"Collectors are interested in exoticism. Objects, plants or animals coming from other regions of the world are called **exotica**!"

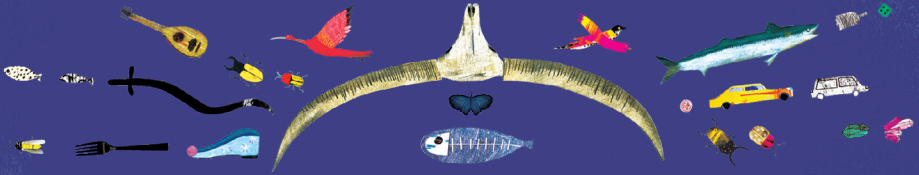
*"Collectors also like to find unusual items related to legendary and imaginary creatures. They collect abnormal and strange things."*

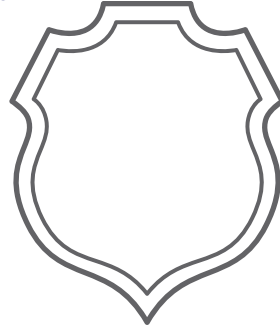
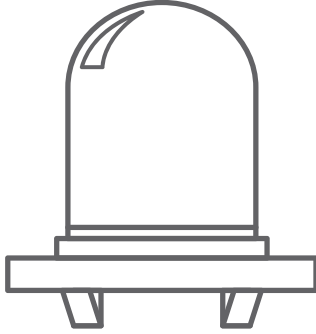
