



# Craft Project

## Pirate Costume



### Pirate Hat



### Materials

1 sheet of black construction paper – 45 cm x 30 cm

White pastel crayon or chalk

Scissors

Hat template to cut out (at the end of this document)





## Instructions

1. Fold the sheet of construction paper in half, lengthwise.



2. Print and cut out the hat template. Place the template on the folded construction paper, placing the dotted line along the folded side. Use the white pastel crayon to trace around the template and then cut out the shape, making sure to cut through both layers of the construction paper.





3. To make an opening for your head, cut a line on your shape as shown on the template. The longer the cut, the bigger the hat will be. Make a shorter cut at first and see how the hat fits. If you need more room, cut a little more until you get a perfect fit.



4. Draw a skull-and-crossbones on the front of your hat with the white pastel crayon. I'll show you how to draw a skull-and-crossbones in the activity video.





## Pirate Eyepatch



### **Material**

Black construction paper

Black yarn, twine, thread, or elastic string

White pastel crayon or chalk

Sharp lead pencil

Eyepatch template to cut out (at the end of this document)

Scissors

### **Instructions**

1. Print and cut out the eyepatch template, then place it on your construction paper. Use the white pastel crayon to trace around the template.







2. Use your sharp lead pencil to poke out the holes on each end, as shown on the template.



3. Cut out the traced eyepatch shape.



4. Draw a skull-and-crossbones on your eyepatch with the white pastel crayon.





5. Take a long length of yarn and pass it through the holes. Tie the yarn around your head to measure the length you need and cut off any excess.





# Pirate Spyglass



## **Material**

- 3 cardboard bathroom tissue rolls
- Black acrylic paint or gouache
- Paintbrush
- Masking tape
- White glue
- Yellow or gold paper (or gold paint)
- Scissors
- Protector for your work surface

## **Instructions**

1. Cut two of the three rolls, lengthwise.





2. Take one of the two cut rolls and insert it into one end of the uncut roll by rolling the cut edges into each other to make it fit. Holding it in position, pull it back out and put some masking tape on both ends to keep its shape.



3. Take the other cut roll and insert it into the roll you just taped, once again by rolling its cut edges into each other to make it fit. Pull out the second roll and put tape on each end to hold the shape. The three rolls should now fit one into the other.







4. Tape the three parts together with some masking tape. Make sure that they are held together solidly.



5. Paint everything black and let it dry. Make sure your work surface is well-protected so you don't stain anything.



6. When the paint is very dry, all that's left to do is add the gold rings to your spyglass. You can use yellow or gold construction paper or gold paint.



**You now have everything you need to dress up as a pirate!
