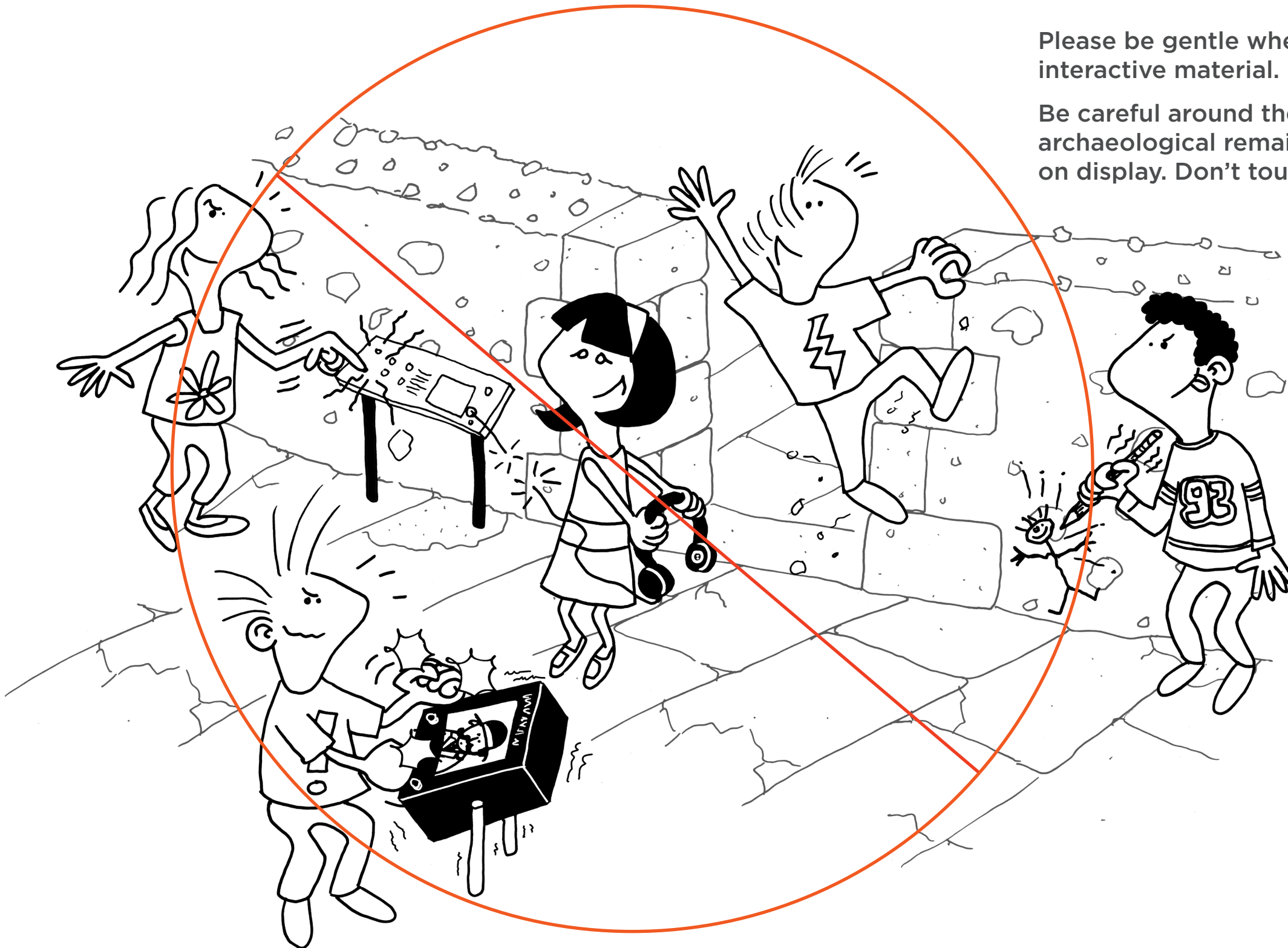
The Museum is a special place.

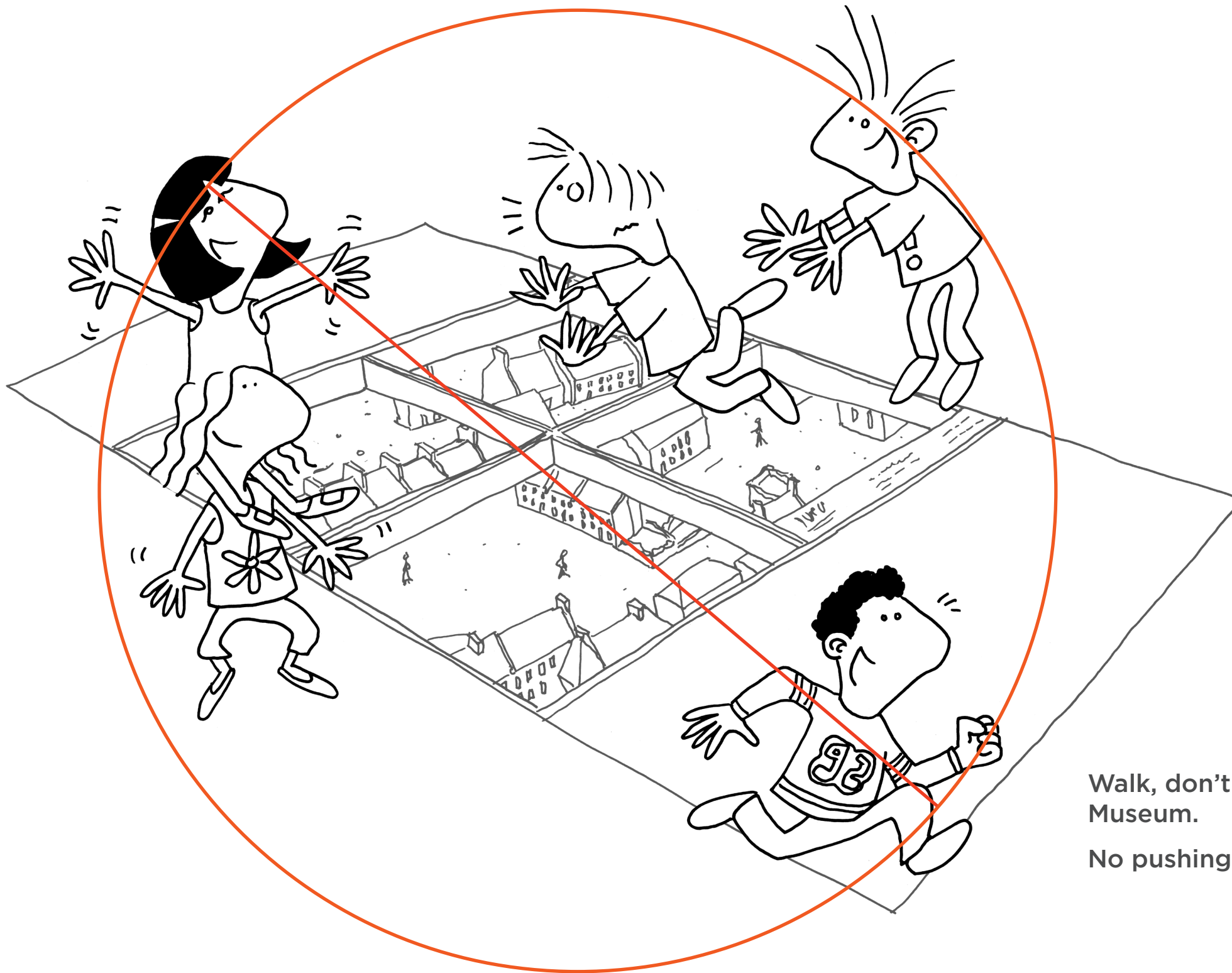
You'll have a chance to see many valuable, fragile

Be careful around the display cases, archaeological remains and items on display. Don't touch!





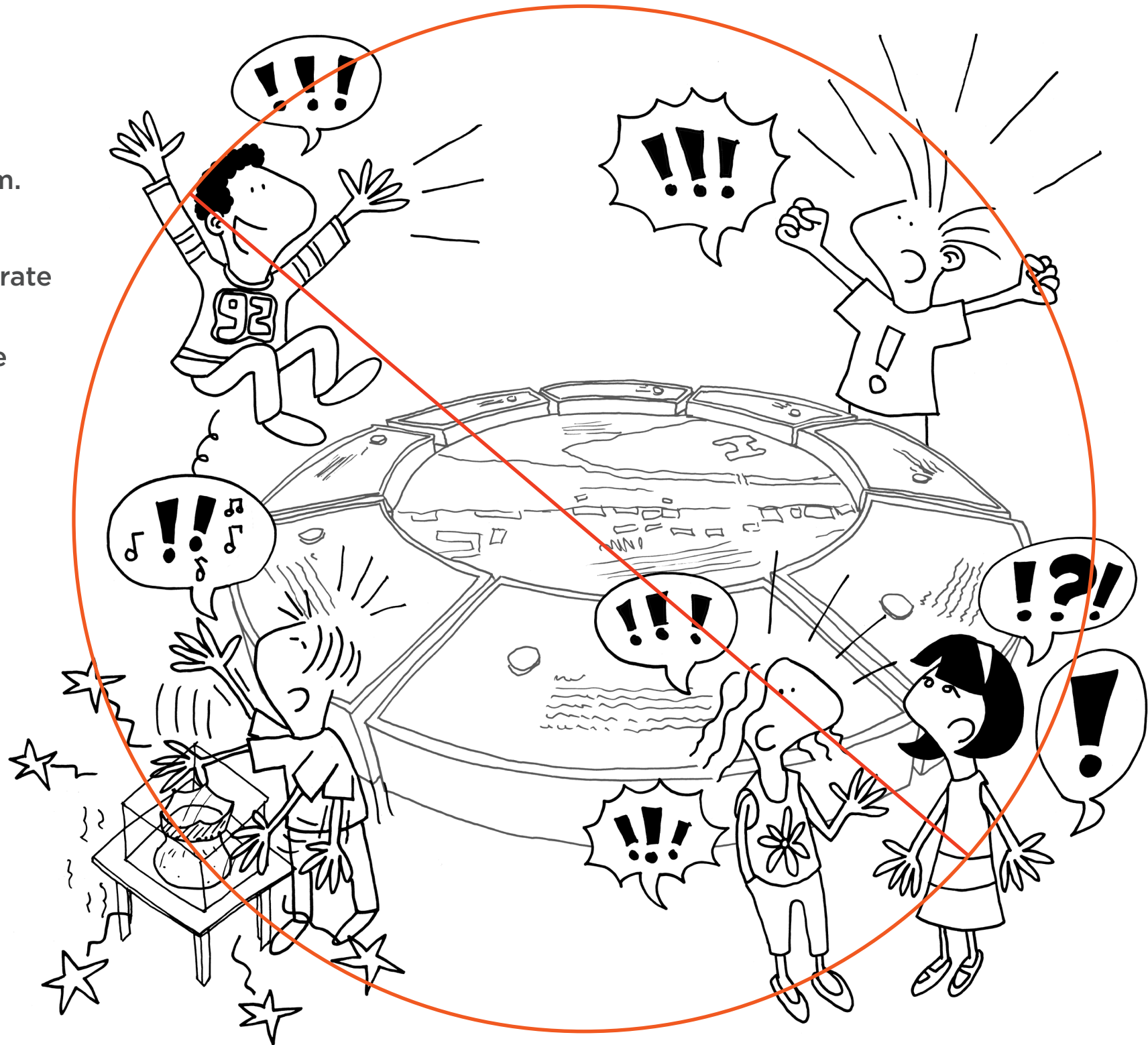
Walk, don't run, in the

No yelling!

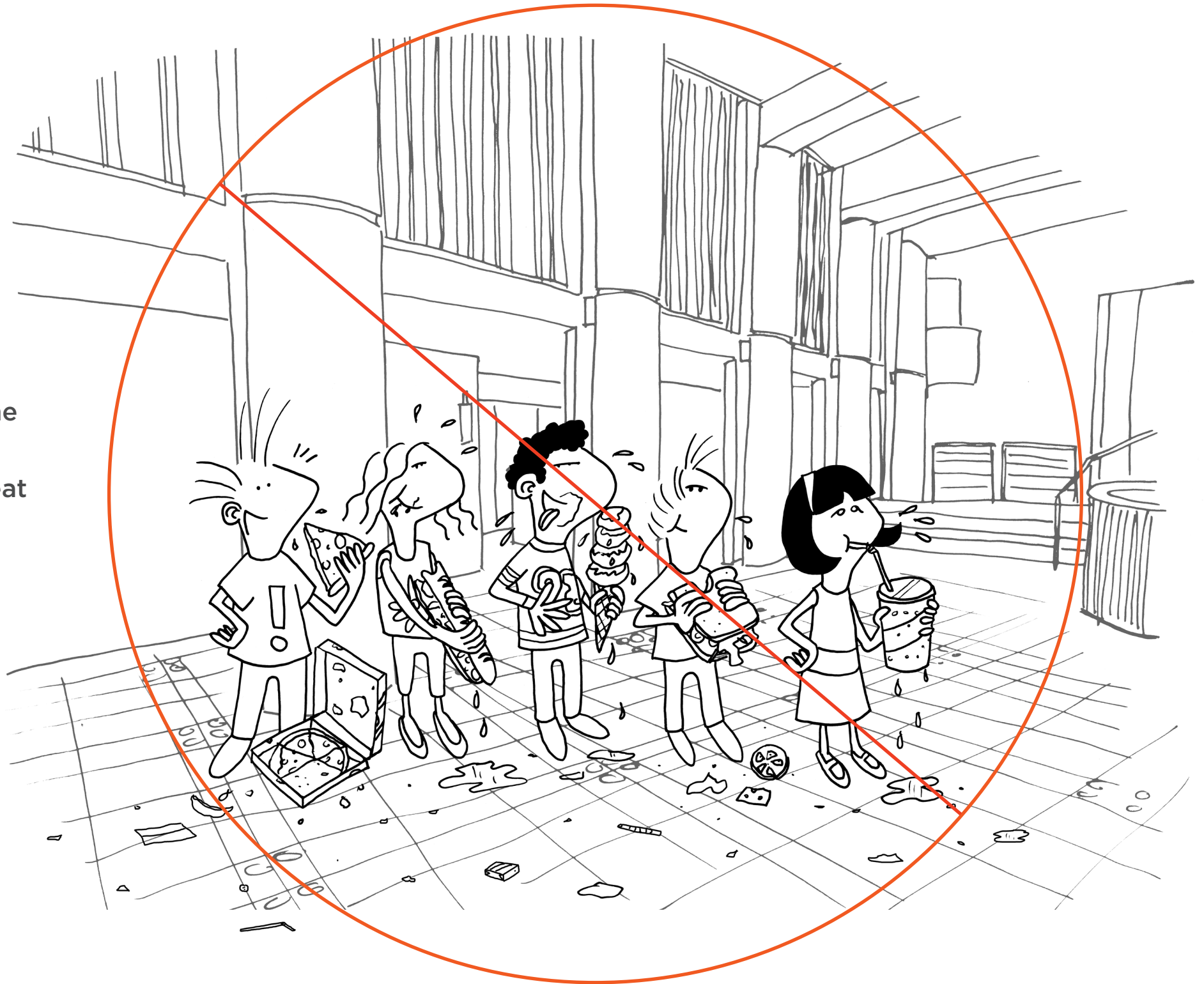
It's important to be considerate
