

# Craft Project: Travel Document Briefcase



## Material

2 sheets of brown construction paper  
Coloured construction paper  
Adhesive tape  
White glue  
Glue stick  
Scissors  
Printed briefcase handle template\*  
Printed travel tags\*

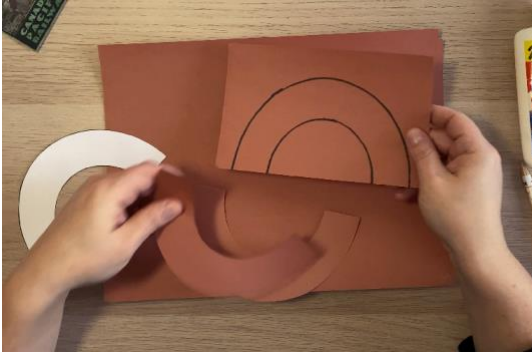

## Steps for making the briefcase

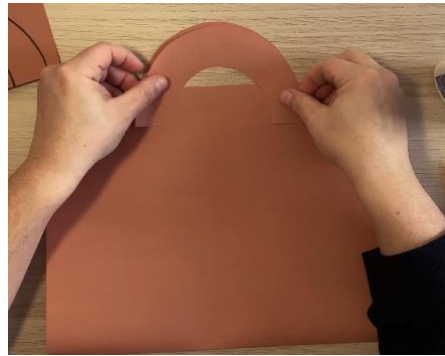
**1.** Place the two sheets of brown construction paper side by side. Using the adhesive tape, stick the two sheets together, lengthwise. Close the briefcase by folding it along the taped edge.



**2.** Prepare the two handles for your briefcase using the template.



**3.** Using white glue, stick the two handles to the top edge of your briefcase. Make sure the handles are aligned.



**4.** Open up your briefcase. Cut two rectangles out of your coloured construction paper to make pockets on each side of your briefcase. You can also cut out a smaller rectangle to make a small pocket. Put some white glue along three sides of each rectangle and stick them into place, making sure the ends without any glue on them are facing up (they will be the open end of each pocket).



**5.** While the glue is drying, cut out and colour in the stickers to decorate your briefcase. Also prepare your luggage tag with your name and destination to attach to the handle of your briefcase. Once this is done, simply glue your stickers to each side of your briefcase using a glue stick.



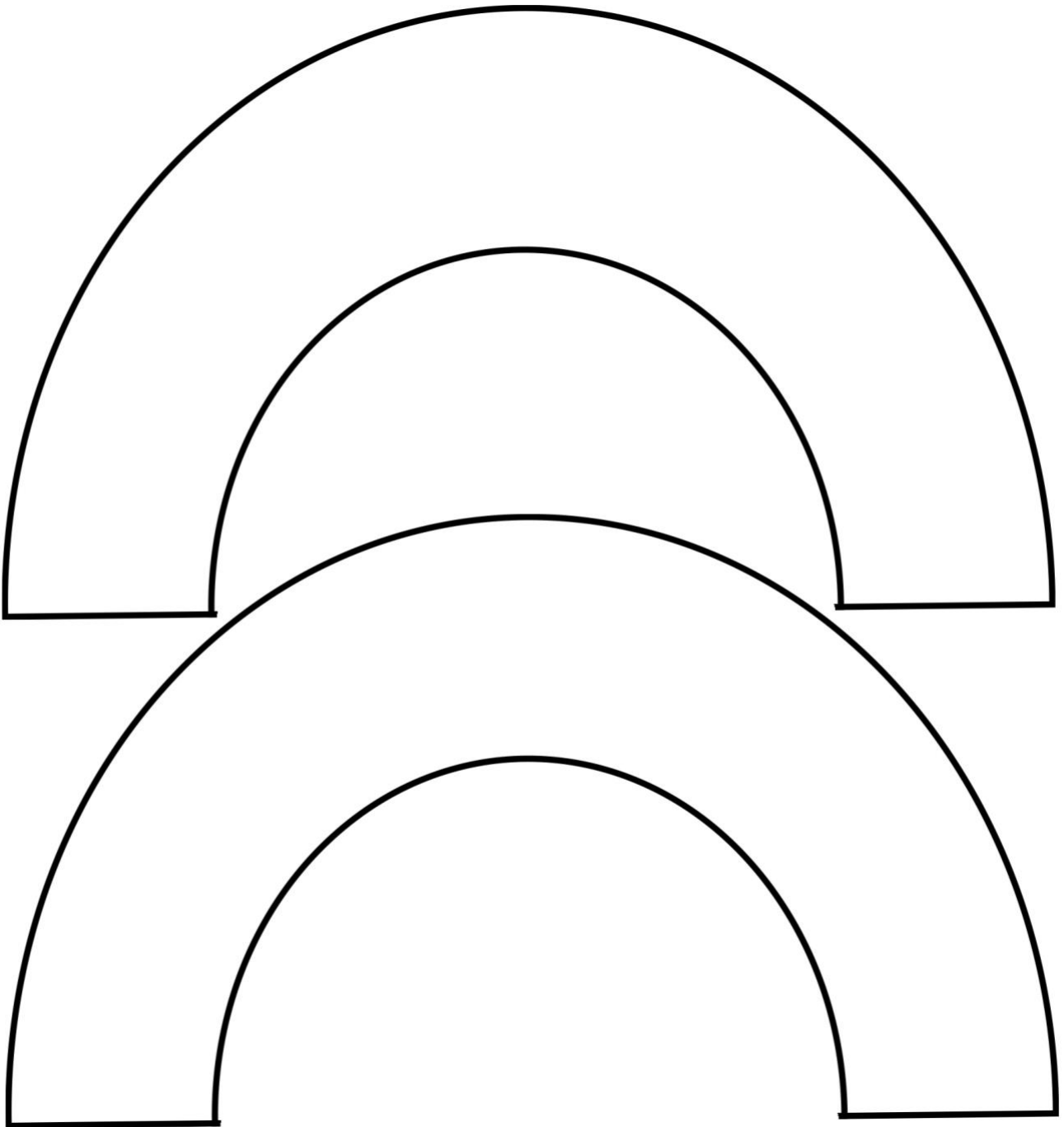
6. You can also add a few more details to make your briefcase look even more authentic. You can round the corners with scissors and create “stitching” around the edges with a felt marker to make it look more like an antique bag.



Your briefcase is now complete! You can use it to hold your drawings, stickers, letters, or other important documents.
