Known as one of Montréal's most dynamic museums,
Pointe-à-Callière is, in fact, a museum complex made up
of five buildings, bringing together cutting-edge technology
and treasures of the past. Located at the birthplace of
Montréal, this spectacular museum, designated a national
historic site, is also a world-class exhibition venue with
unique spaces that can host private events in a setting
that is rich in history.

Renowned for its archaeological sites and remains, the Museum offers an impressive, inspiring, and unusual backdrop, with 11 areas and spaces that lend themselves well to all manner of events and receptions: launches, inaugurations, cocktail parties, happy hours, business meetings, various types of assemblies, colloquia, gourmet meals, anniversaries, celebrations, and fireworks evenings. Its various multifunctional rooms are among the best equipped in Montréal.

The Museum is located just a few minutes from the downtown core, in historic Old Montréal, and it offers exceptional views of the Old Port, the St. Lawrence River, and the city of Montréal.

1. Hydro-Québec Multimedia Theatre

Spectacular, built above the archaeological remains, with an immersive 270° screen. 144 people seated 180 people – total capacity

2. Lobby

Prestigious, with a contemporary design offering views of the archaeological remains, and featuring a work of art by Peter Kraus.


250 people standing – cocktail parties 120 people seated – banquets

3. L'Arrivage Restaurant

Located on the 2nd floor of the Museum, bathed in light and offering magnificent views of Old Montréal and the Old Port. 125 people standing – cocktail parties 110 people seated – banquets

4. Multipurpose Room

Brightly lit, overlooking the lobby and the Old Port promenade.
60 people – theatre style 35 people – in rows or U shape







Majestic glass-walled room on the roof of the building, offering spectacular views of Old Montréal, the Old Port, and the city of Montréal.

175 people standing – cocktail parties 60 people – banquets

80 people – theatre style

2. Lobby

Natural light and transparency, a modern and friendly atmosphere. With a work of art by Nicolas Baier and a digital fresco by Moment Factory. 175 people standing – cocktail parties

3. Admiral Room

Modern and well-equipped, ideal for business and board meetings. 18 people at a conference table

4. Azure Room

Very versatile, boasting large windows that offer remarkable views of the Old Port and the St. Lawrence River. 100 people standing – cocktail parties 60 people – theatre style 40 people – in rows 35 people – U shape

5. Members' Room

Ideal for relaxed, friendly get-togethers. Adjacent to the Azure Room. 20 people – lounge style

6. Partners' Room

For comfortable smaller meetings in a welcoming setting. 8 people at a conference table
